

Dr. Burgess Weekly Video Address August 6, 2015
“Keller/Ft. Worth and Denton Town Hall Recap”

Hello this is your Congressman, Michael Burgess. I'm speaking to you this evening from the campus of Timber Creek High School in Keller, Texas. We just finished up a town hall here this evening, and had pretty good participation. Two nights ago, I did a similar event up in Denton at Guyer High School.

I've heard from a variety of constituents this week on a number of issues. Certainly many people are concerned about the agreement that the President is currently proposing with the country of Iran, which will allow Iran to develop their nuclear capabilities. Many people do feel this is not in the best interests of the United States, and you know what? I agree with them. I'll be voting against this proposition when it comes to the floor of the House in September.

Another thing we've heard about is trade agreements. There's been a lot discussed about that. I do want to encourage you, as the trade agreements are made public, please have a look at them. Provide my office feedback as to what you think. I did vote against the Trade Promotion Authority as it was proposed at the end of May and the beginning of June.

I doubt I will be in favor of the Trans-Pacific partnership, I see many defects within that agreement, but I do welcome your input and your observations, when this document indeed becomes public and you have a chance to look at it.

But mostly what I've heard tonight is concern by a lot of good citizens, who are concerned about the direction of their country, concerned about the safety and security of our nation. I share their concern.
